Government Procurement and Various International Issues:***

- 1. The Buy American Act (“BAA”) and the Trade Agreements Act (“TAA”) shape much of Federal procurement. This seminar will discuss key elements of the BAA and TAA, including:**
  - BAA and TAA: What the statutes and regulations actually say .... and mean
  - “Substantial Transformation” under the TAA – qualification and analysis
  - Building a BAA and TAA Compliance Program
  - U.S. Content under FMS and FMF Programs
  - U.S. Production issues under SBIRs and other R&D Programs
  - The Berry Amendment and other “Buy National” requirements; and
  - Prime-Sub issues under the BAA and TAA
  
- 2. Export Compliance is a close cousin to government contracts. The seminar will discuss:**
  - The basic ITAR and EAR export control system;
  - The interplay between export controls and government contractors; and
  - FCPA, Sanctions, and other international Codes of Conduct.
  
- 3. The role of “non-U.S. persons” in federal procurement is a day to day reality for both the government and its contractors. The seminar will discuss:**
  - Foreign citizens working on U.S. government contracts: security clearances, and beyond;
  - Issues related to the purchase of, or investment in, government contractors by foreign firms and individuals; and
  - FMS and FMF financing and contracts.
