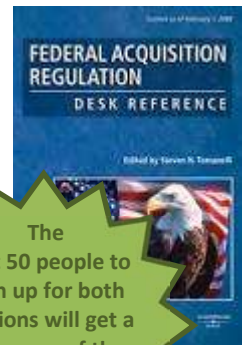


How to Register and Pay:
