Given the current backlog of audits to be performed by the Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA), the Government may not be able to initiate counter-claims against contractors as quickly as in the past. Given this current state, it is important for the parties to know the statute of limitations on such claims - when does the clock start ticking? In the event the contractor is asked to recertify their claim, the contractor should know under which circumstances this is an appropriate request and the impact that this recertification will have on the claim process.
