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A contractor's ability to participate in a bid protest or even follow the proceedings is sharply circumscribed, because of the terms of the protective orders which are issued for protests at the GAO and COFC. In such circumstances, how can a company support its protest legal team and give its attorneys the best opportunity for success? This presentation will focus on the company's role in a bid protest, exploring the best practices for these activities.
